Most failed automation is automation of the wrong process. This workshop teaches you to judge a process before you automate it: when to simplify first, when to automate and when to leave it with a human.

WHAT WE COVER

- Why automation fails: the pattern behind most disappointing projects
- Process triage: a practical filter to decide simplify, automate or leave alone
- Simplify first: removing steps, exceptions and approvals before any tool is chosen
- The economics: real cost of automation including maintenance, exceptions and change
- Human in the loop: tasks where a person is the feature, not the bottleneck
- Case work: participants run the triage on processes from their own organisation
